Elaine Summers; Choreographer, Intermedia Artist

Elaine Summers has worked in a variety of forms, including dance, film and Intermedia. She was one of the original members of Judson Dance Theater and a founder of Experimental Intermedia Foundation. During the Judson years, she was a pioneer of Intermedia works such as *Overture* and *Fantastic Gardens*. In 1968 she founded Experimental Intermedia Foundation, and she was artistic director of the *First Intermedia Festival* at the Guggenheim Museum in 1984 and the *Second Intermedia Festival* at the University of Iowa in 1987.

Don McDonagh and Robert Dunn chronicled the beginning of Intermedia:

"McD: There's an interesting description by John McDowell of the opening of the first concert: 'The very first dance that ever happened at Judson was really very extraordinary in a couple of ways. First, the beginning of it, which was Bob Dunn's doing and was beautiful. The dance concert was announced to start at 8:15 and they went upstairs into the sanctuary to find that in order to get to their seats they had to walk across a movie that was going on. This movie consisted of some chance edited footage by Elaine Summers and test footage that I made... And we went on exactly, precisely for 15 minutes. The first dance which was by Ruth Emerson started on the dot of 8:30. As the movie was just about to go off, the six people or so involved came out, the movie sort of dissolved into the dance.'

Dunn: Yes this was really incredible, the beginning of the first (Judson)concert. It doesn't sound like much now but it was extraordinary, my hair stands on end to think how that worked. Nobody ever did anything like that."*

Elaine Summers founded the Kinetic Awareness Center in 1987, a body therapy and system for understanding connections between mind and body.

Her work is currently being archived at the Jerome Robbins Dance Collection of Lincoln Center Public Library.

SkyDance Skytime Skyweb Improvization with Sun Moon & Stars is her ongoing pursuits of creating 'Rainbow' - a combined effect of different elements which in her case are dance and projected images. It features Kiori Kawai solo dancing with multiple projections of sky and stars. In continuation of the developing evolution of SkyDance Skytime Skyweb, and as a transection of a multiplicity of times and places, Thomas Körtvélyessy will be joining this stage of the ongoing performance via satellite from Rotterdam, The Netherlands. It was premiered at St. Marks Church/Danspace on March 18th, 2010 for *Platform 2010* curated by Juliette Mapp. It was also performed at Ione's 15th Annual Dream Festival on November 5th, 2010, and to standing ovations at *Improvizações – Colaborações*, Auditorium Museu de Arte Contemporanea, Fundação de Serralves, in Porto, Portugal

Elaine Summers has worked with such artists as Pauline Oliveros, Ione, Davidson Gigliotti, Trisha Brown, Nam June Paik, James Byrne, Meredith Monk, Malcolm Goldstein, Philip Corner, Jon Gibson and Paula Court.
